Antique Reclaimed Hickory

Species	Carya Cordiformis, Carya Glabra, Carya Lacinosa et al
Hardness	Janka 1820
Thickness	3/4"
Coloration	Cream to warm medium brown natural color variation, some darker highlights and occasional ferrous metal stain
Grade Characteristics	Light to medium natural grain variation, some remnant original saw kerf, tight or star cracked knots, minor checks or cracks to 1/8" on plank face, light to medium worm hole content, few to moderate nail holes and occasional fillable holes or voids to 3/4"
Widths	Available 3"-8" RW(3"-5"), RW(3"-6"), RW(4"-7"), RW(5"-8") standard
Lengths	2' to 10'
Moisture Content	6%-9% at production
Millwork	Milled from a mix of planks re-sawn from reclaimed timbers and reclaimed weathered boards with offset floor-matched tongue and groove, back-relieved End matching available to 10"
Packaging	Hand carry bundles of 4 boards high, 8'-12' long, securely strapped to wood skid of 36"-42" wide x 12'
Eco Status	LEED MRc3 Eligible - 100% Reclaimed
