Antique Reclaimed Oak – Highlands Plank

Species	Quercus rubra, Quercus Alba (mixed red & white oak)
Hardness	Janka 1290 - 1360
Thickness	3/4"
Coloration	Medium tan to darker nut brown natural oxidized color variation with some darker highlights and occasional ferrous metal stain
Grade Characteristics	Natural medium to bold grain variation, original old sawn texture on +/- 50% of plank face (fiber brushed to lightly clean surface), tight or star cracked knots, minor checks and cracks to 1/8", few worm holes, few to moderate nail holes and occasional fillable holes or voids to 3/4"
Widths	Available 3"-10", limited quantities 11" & wider RW(3"-5"), RW(3"-6"), RW(4"-7"), RW(5"-8") standard
Lengths	2' to 10'
Moisture Content	6%-9% at production
Millwork	Milled from reclaimed planks exhibiting original old sawn texture with offset floor-matched tongue and groove, back-relieved End matching available to 10"
Packaging	Hand carry bundles of 4 boards high, 8'-12' long, securely strapped to wood skid of 36"-42" wide x 12'
Eco Status	LEED MRc3 Eligible - 100% Reclaimed
